Her work focuses on implementation of emergency department harm reduction, addiction treatment, and peer navigation programs.

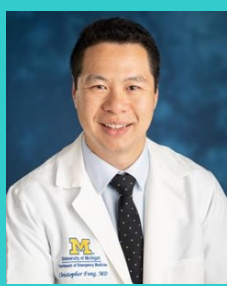
